Timing: All tournaments open for registration at 8.30am, and games begin at 9.00am. Finish times vary.

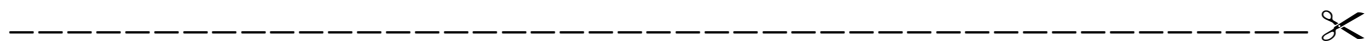
