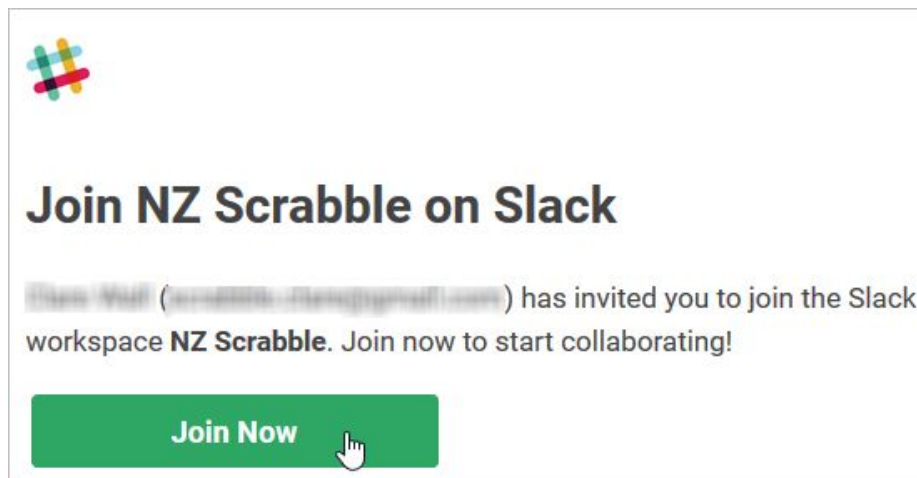
Get set up

1. Email the administrator, Steven Brown at sgbrown@mac.com, to be invited in to Slack.

Include in the email:

- a. Your name
- b. The name of your club.

2. When Steven has set you up, you'll receive an email from Slack. Open it and click 'Join Now'.



2. You'll see the form below. Enter:

- Your name.
- Your 'display name' (the name that will appear in Slack - most people just use their name).
- A password you'll use each time you log in to Slack. Make sure it's one you'll remember!

Click 'Next'.

Display name (optional)

By default, Slack will use your full name — but you can choose something shorter if you'd like.

Password (required)

Passwords must be at least 6 characters long, and can't be things like "password", "123456" or "abcdef".



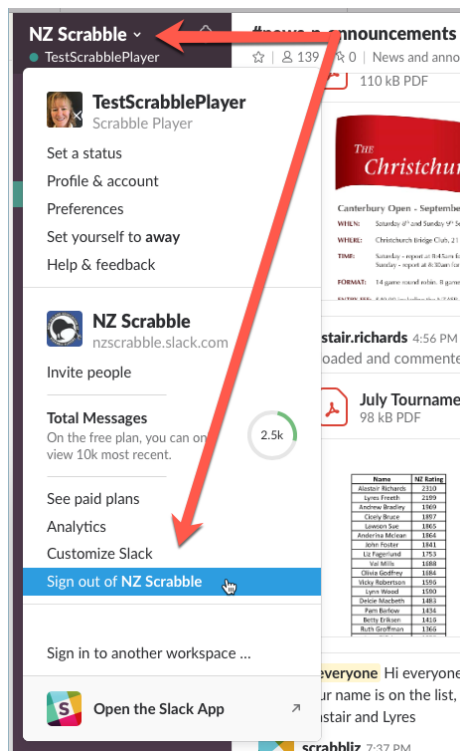
